EQAO Results

The results from the 2016-2017 EQAO tests have been published. Of the students who participated in the tests, the following scores were achieved:

Grade 3: Reading WEJ 82%, Board 73%, Province 74%; Writing WEJ 85%, Board 70%, Province 73%; Mathematics WEJ 77%, Board 58%, Province 62%

Grade 6: WEJ Reading 95%, Board 84%, Province 81%; Writing WEJ 96%, Board 79%, Province 79%; Mathematics WEJ 83%, Board 51%, Province 50%.

Children who achieve a level 3 or more are considered to be working at grade level. The School Improvement Committee will be analysing these results, along with other pertinent material, to develop a School Improvement Plan.
