- Approval of Agenda motion approved
- Principal update (Colleen Irvin):
  - As you know we had one positive case of COVID-19 last weekend. We worked closely with OPH all day Sunday to determine how to proceed, and it was very effective. It seems that we were able to contain the case and that no community spread occurred within the school. Kids and teachers are coming back to school later this week.
  - Report cards are coming out this week and teacher interviews will occur next week (Starting Thurs 26th). This Friday, interview booking will go live on Friday at 12:00pm
  - School budget much lower than previous (based on the number of students in our school - \$18k) We may get a carry-forward but not yet sure, should find out by the next meeting in January.
  - School spending: online resources for teaching staff, french resources, RAZ kids, brain & brain pop, gym equipment. Some money was given to school by the council last year but we didn't get to spend it before we left in March, so we used this money for some of the above items.
  - Future ideas for spending:
- Vice Principal update (Sean Davidson):
  - Bully prevention & awareness week: reviewing W.I.T.S program, daily announcements, reviews in classrooms, poster contest (look on Twitter!)
  - Buses: the striped bus was leaving late but we were able to work with OSTA to adjust the buses and it is arriving and leaving on time now by 4:00pm.
  - Bus safety: OSTA has shared 30 min videos for students for bus safety to review soon
  - Recess: 7 zones in the yard, classes rotate through.
  - Phys ed classes: has been outside to date. We are allowed to bring out sports equipment now (Board approved) which the teachers and students all enjoy. One cohort is using the equipment at a time for a week, and then the equipment is cleaned on the weekend for another

class the following week. We will start using the gym inside, one cohort at a time

- WEJ Spirit Wear launching today!! Online store, available until Nov.26th to be ready for Christmas (est. Delivery Dec.14). We will relaunch it in the new year for future purchases. A portion of the proceeds will go to the school, and it will be delivered to the school for free and distributed from there. - Teacher updates (Aniqua Khan)
  - Virtual Parent-Teacher night in October some did google meets, powerpoints and videos.

- Financial Update Saami Hamid
  - Opening balance: \$10,758.64
  - Refunds still need to be made to some for hot lunches back last spring: \$5051.55
  - Projects (ongoing): playground mulch: \$2000
  - Cash/bank/paypal floats: \$1000 (for paying website, etc)
  - Available: \$2707.09 for spending
- Projects/Items to fund right now no items on the list, will get input for next meeting in January (Colleen)
